Three letters in which Leander Rand, Major commanding the 1st Regiment Kings County Nova Scotia Militia, attests to the training of three of his men Note: On verso, minutes (1864) of a meeting held in the school house at Cornwallis on 25 October 1864. Those present decided to 'support a school agreeable to the new School law'. Also contains a list of the 'rateable inhabitants of School Section 57'
