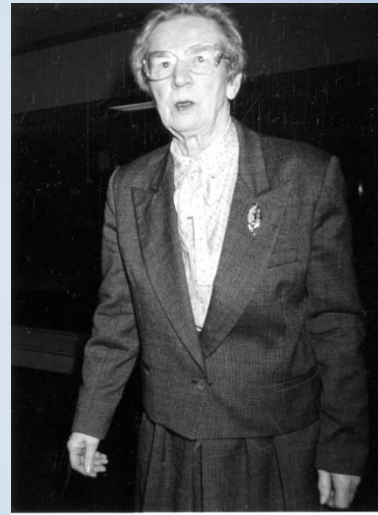

Biographical Sketch – Isaac Judson Levy

Nova Scotia on July 15, 1907. He received his preparatory education in Sherwood School after which he entered Acadia and received a Bachelor of Arts in Theology in 1931. He continued his education at Andover Newton Theology School in Boston, Massachusetts, where he received a Bachelor of Divinity in 1944 and a Master of Sacred Theology in 1951. He received an honorary doctorate from Acadia University in 1956.

I. Judson Levy worked as a Boys' Work Secretary of the Maritime Religious Education Council from 1931 to 1935. He became the pastor of the United Baptist Church in Sussex, N.B. in 1936 and married Fernetta Geraldine Barchard of Elgin, N.B. (then living in Saint John) on August 5, 1939. In 1940 the couple moved to Charlottetown, P.E.I., where Judson was pastor until 1947 when he became pastor of the First Baptist Church in Moncton, N.B. He subsequently pastored in St. Catherines and Hamilton, Ontario but returned to the Maritimes to assume the position of University Chaplain at Acadia University from 1964 to 1975. During this time he occasionally taught courses at the Acadia Divinity College.

Beyond his duties as pastor, I. Judson Levy was active in the Baptist community. He was a founding member of The Atlantic Seminar in Theological Education and following his retirement from Acadia University was editor of the newsletter for the Atlantic Baptist Fellowship. He was also the author of four books, listed below, and was life president of Acadia University class of 1931.

I. Judson Levy died at the age of 85 on October 16, 1992 in Windsor, Nova Scotia.

Biographical Sketch – Fernetta Levy

A native of Elgin, NB, Fernetta Levy studied at the New Brunswick Teachers' College and the Saint John Business College. Afterwards, she taught in both public and business schools. She later studied at Andover Theological School while her husband, I. Judson, was doing post-graduate work there.

Later in life she was a member of the Councils of the Baptist Convention of the Atlantic Provinces, the Baptist Federation of Canada, the Canadian Baptist Overseas Mission Board, and the United Baptist Women's Missionary Union (U.B.W.M.U.). She was the president of the North American Baptist Women's Union, U.B.W.M.U., the Nova Scotia District of the Canadian Bible Society (the first woman to serve in this capacity), and was the first Canadian woman to be a vice-president of the United Bible Societies.

Fernetta Levy received an honorary Doctor of Divinity degree from Acadia University in 1979, the first woman to do so and the first woman to deliver the Baccalaureate sermon. Fernetta Levy died in Truro, Nova Scotia, on 12 July 2004.

Custodial History

At the time of the compilation of this finding aid, Judson Levy's records were found in the same boxes as those of his brother George Levy. George Levy's papers had been transferred to the executor of his estate following his death in 1981. It is thought that the executor, Ed. Eagles, went through George's papers and discarded some as he thought appropriate. He then donated them to the Acadia University Archives on 31 August 1987.

It is unclear whether the records of Judson and Fernetta Levy's were included with this donation. Perhaps, but if not, at some point their records were combined with that donated by Eagles.

During processing in 2003, the Archivist separated Judson's records from George's and created two distinct fonds.

The fonds contains the correspondence, reference material, published writings, and miscellaneous records of I. Judson and Fernetta Levy.
