Curry Milton Spidell was born in 1893 in Lunenburg County, NS. He attended Acadia Academy before joining the military and serving in France during World War One (1916). After graduating from Acadia in 1924 with a B.A., he was a student of theology at Rochester between 1925 and 1927. Spidell was a Chaplain with the U.S. Army in World War Two, Pacific theatre and later was a chaplain with the U.S. Department of Justice. He married Beatrice Irene Innes, Acadia Class of 1923, who was born in Sydney, Cape Breton in 1901. She taught English and French in New Hampshire.
