Photo album, between 1920 and 1924, in 69 folders. Includes:

- individuals from the Class of 1924, and
- the campus, including the fire of 1920.

Item is an unbound album of photographs mounted on Bristol board and consisting of five double-sided 'boards' containing sixty-nine photographs. Since the pages of the album were not numbered and the creator's original order cannot be determined, an arbitrary decision was made regarding numbering the photos.

In the album, the creator often identified persons in the photos by nickname or by initials. By comparing these to the known members of the Class of 1924, the archivist has attempted to make identifications; these guesses have been placed in square brackets. Therefore, many photographs are only partially identified and many are unidentified.

For reasons of historic authenticity, all file titles provided by the author and captions provided by the photographer are transcribed unedited. The spelling of both peoples' and places' names has changed with time, so inaccuracies and inconsistencies in the titles are unavoidable. Files and captions may also contain inaccuracies or terms that would now be considered offensive.

- 1900.199-AUC/17** Four unidentified women. – [192-?]. – 1 photograph : b&w ; 10.5 x 6.5 cm. Photograph depicts four unidentified young women standing in middle of open area with the Whitman Hall in background.
- 1900.199-AUC/18** Mose [?] & Percy [Kempton?] shoveling snow. – [192-?]. – 1 photograph : b&w ; 10 x 6 cm . Photograph depicts two men shoveling snow from the walk way in front of the Whitman Hall. "Mose & Percy" inscribed on album page in pen.
- 1900.199-AUC/19** Three unidentified young men. – [192-?]. – 1 photograph : b&w ; 7 x 11 cm. Photograph depicts three unidentified young men standing arm-in-arm.
- 1900.199-AUC/20** Acadia University campus in winter. – [192-?]. – 1 photograph : b&w ; 10.5 x 6.5 cm. Photograph depicts Rhodes Hall, Carnegie Hall, Willet Hall and Horton Academy on the Acadia University campus near the top of the hill. In this photograph Rhodes Hall has three stories. The third story was not built until September 1919 so the photo had to have been taken after this time
- 1900.199-AUC/21** Acadia University campus buildings. – [192-?]. – 1 photograph : sepia toned ; 8 x 6 cm. Photograph depicts Willet Hall, Emerson Library, Carnegie Hall and Rhodes Hall at Acadia University covered in snow. In this photograph Rhodes Hall has three stories. The third story was not built until September 1919 so the photo had to have been taken after this time

The extreme left is on the seminary grounds.

- 1900.199-AUC/40** Ten unidentified individuals at the beach. – [192-?]. – 1 photograph : sepia toned ; 8 x 6.5 cm. Photograph depicts a group of ten unidentified individuals posing at [Evangeline beach?]
- 1900.199-AUC/41** Twenty-one unidentified men. – [192-?]. – 1 photograph : sepia toned ; 11 x 6.5 cm. Photograph depicts twenty-one unidentified men posing in front of a brick building. Note: Torn at top
