Numerous other names are mentioned along with details of work done or goods received. The Estate of Dr. William C. Dennison is listed as is work done on dykes in the Township of Horton.
1900.058-DEN/2	lease	1910	Lease between Dr. Henry Chipman of Grand Pre and Francis C. Dennison of Hortonville, farmer, for a lot of dyke land on the Grand Pre Dyke.
1900.058-DEN/3	lease agreement	1910	Lease agreement between J. Marion White of Grand Pre and F.C. Dennison of Hortonville concerning a lot of dyked marsh land purchased from James N. Fuller.
1900.058-DEN/4	indenture	1910	Indenture between George R. Chipman of Grand Pre, listed as a vet. student, and Francis C. Dennison of Hortonville, farmer, for two lots of dyke land on the Grand Pre Dyke
