Memorial is a large stone structure with a statue of a soldier on top of it. There is plaque on the front of the stone structure. A small flower garden is in front of the memorial and trees appear to the side and behind the memorial. The memorial stands beside the current post office on Main Street, Wolfville. - Annotation on front of postcard: "The War Memorial, Wolfville Nova Scotia. -8."

1900.381-AVI/24 The Public School, Wolfville, Nova Scotia. - [19-]. - 1 postcard : col. ; 8.5 x 13.5 cm. - Image of the front of the public school in Wolfville, the Munro School, which was located on Acadia Street. It was built in 1921 and demolished in 1971. Large trees appear on either side of the school and a fence is visible on the left side of the school. - Annotation on front of photo "The Public School, Wolfville, Nova Scotia - 10."

1900.381-AVI/25 Main Street Looking West, Wolfville, N.S. - [19-].- 1 postcard : col. ; 8.5 x 13.5 cm. - Image of Main Street, Wolfville, looking west. There is a horse and carriage driving down the centre of the unpaved road and a pedestrian is visible in the distance. Another building is just visible behind the church. It is also known as the Covenanters Church because the minister from 1833-1840 was a reformed Presbyterian, or Covenanter. It is the oldest Presbyterian church building in Canada (built between 1804 and 1811). - Annotation on front of postcard: "Old Church Grand Pre N.S." Inscribed on reverse in pencil and ink: "Grand Pre Minas Basin / Went in to this / old church. Not / well kept up - / Built about 1810."
